



**City of Dallas Park and Recreation Department
Code of Conduct – Coach/Captain**

The Coach/Captain:

1. Drugs/Alcohol are not permitted on recreation center and park property
2. Physical and verbal abuse, loud or intimidating behavior is prohibited by coaches, players and spectators and will not be tolerated.
3. Coach/Captain are responsible for maintaining control of players, parents and spectators that are there in support of their team
4. Coach/Captains should demonstrate good sportsmanship and set an example for their players and spectators at all times. They must accept that both correct and incorrect calls are part of the game and teach players to concentrate on playing the game.
5. Players, coaches, and managers who have been ejected/suspended must leave the facility and grounds immediately or the team will forfeit the game, and must not return until the completion of the suspension.
6. Suspensions will carry over from season to season. Example: A player suspended for the final two games of one season will also be suspended for the first game of the next season.
7. Physical violence, especially attacks on a game or tournament official immediately before, during, or after a game or fights/ confrontations between players/teams will result in a minimum of one (1) year loss of eligibility in all league play or indefinite suspension in all league play, subject to an annual review if requested. Final Decision will be made by League Commissioner.

I agree to abide by the DPARD Code of Conduct and understand that any violation of these terms may result in being ejected from the facility/playing field and face suspension, forfeiture of the game or coach/team being suspended indefinitely.
