

Runyon Creek Trail

The Runyon Creek Trail, located in south Dallas, will be located within existing park property that comprises the Runyon Creek Greenbelt linking Five Mile Creek Greenbelt, Glendale Park and Singing Hills Park. It will provide a direct connection to an existing segment of the Five Mile Creek Greenbelt and Glendale Park Loop Trail. The Runyon Creek Trail will connect into the planned University of North Texas Campus and the planned extension of the Dallas Area Rapid Transit (DART) light rail. As identified in the Singing Hills Park Master Plan, the Runyon Creek Trail will be located within or adjacent to the old Interurban Railway alignment, which creates a unique historical interpretive opportunity.
